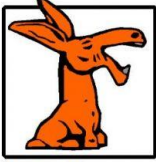


Troop 279 B.S.A

These photos and videos are also important so that prospective Boy Scouts and their families are able to view the numerous and fun activities that are unique to Troop 279.

Note: Troop 279 will not post the names of any Scouts or persons under the age of 18 (unless publishing an article from newsprint or other news media when the names already were included in the article), and only the names of those over the age of 18 on a case by case permission basis.
